Minutes: 2017 Secretary, Kimberly Roberts, provided minutes of the November 2017 meeting. Sarah Kozul made a motion to accept minutes as presented, Vicki Powell second all approved.

Treasure Report: 2017 Treasurer, Betsy Slay, presented the income statement for November & December 2017. Ending balance as of 11/30/18 \$73,045.64 and ending balance as of 12/31/17 \$77,007.87. Kurtis Braun made a motion to accept the financial reports as presented, chuck McDanal second all approved.

The Pack shirts - email approval on 12/7/17 to purchase shirts for The Pack group not to exceed \$650. Approved by Vicki, Kristi, Kimberly, Angi, Sarah, Rhonda, Chuck, Louis, Lynn, Betsy, Kurtis, and Gail. Invoice came to \$657.00, need approval for the additional \$7 amount.

Kurtis Braun made a motion to approve the extra \$7 for the Pack shirts, Betsy Slay second, all approved.

Runners will need to attend 10 sessions and be a current member of LRC to receive their shirts.

Track Workouts with Milton, will also be getting shirts with the same 10 sessions and current membership with LRC to receive their shirt.

Hill workouts - Open discussion on ways to bring Hill Runners back into LRC and attending monthly general meetings - possibly purchasing shirts for them with same guidelines to receive shirt as Pack and Track workouts. Gail to talk with Dave on this.

Speakers for our General Meetings - Milton will help with the speakers.

Chuck suggested a different format for 2018, each quarter have:

1 meeting with a speaker

1 meeting with just fellowship

1 meeting with open mike and member participation (favorite race, favorite shirt) etc.

Board liked this idea and we will move forward with this plan for 2018.

Rebecca suggested paying a more well-known speaker to come in, we will look into this option as well.

Sponsor letters - sent out on 12/18/17, to Beer Rev, Black & Brew, Foot & Ankle, Hand & Stone, Howell & Thornhill, Leading Edge, Love Chiropractic, MidFlorida, Polk State College, Publix Charities, Thrivent Financial, Watson Clinic Foundation. Also sent on 12/20/17 to Orange Theory and Geico. We are looking for suggestions for new sponsors as well.

Sponsor Money - is divided among our races: MidFlorida \$7,000 to Mayfaire 5K and the other \$5,000 is divided evenly for the other 4 races, \$1250 each. All other full sponsor money is divided evenly between all of our race for the year.

We want to honor and thank our sponsors at all of our races, some suggestions:

Mile marker signs with sponsors listed based on the amount of sponsorship and big sign at the finish for top sponsors.

Sponsor banner at the finish line with Velcro pieces that can be changed out as some sponsors are race specific.

Watermark to go around finish and race photos with sponsors done around in a frame on picture.

These are options to consider for our 2019 race season as 2018 sponsor letters have already been sent out.

Scholarship program - Kurtis will be sending information to all board members in March to pick our recipients for this year.

Plans for 2018:

Gail had a meeting with the City of Lakeland on 1/11/18 to go over our race plans, we cannot use Fletcher Park for our Double Down 5K race venue and Lake to Lake 10 K date has changed to 10/6/18 due to a conflict. The city wants to block more streets during Lake to Lake and they will put up barricades at several intersections and will get back with us on the costs for this.

We need a new venue for Double Down 5K, if anyone has any ideas, let Kurtis and Gail know. We need race director for MidFlorida Mayfaire 5K, Sydney Devore is taking over Lake to Lake 10K.

FitNiche timing contract renewed for 2018 with the same pricing as the last two years.

LRC race dates have been set for 2018 and 2019 and turned into the City of Lakeland.

RRCA race calendar has been updated.

RRCA 2018 insurance has been paid at \$2,040.00.

RRCA additional insurance submitted for all races and the Track Workout and the Kids Running.

Membership switched from RunSignUp to Local Races to enable on-line vouchers.

RRCA Convention is 4/5/ - 4/8/18 - hotel have been booked - Betsy, Kurtis, Gail & Louis going. The board sends the president and 2 members each year to the convention. If anyone else would like to go the club will pay registration fees, but member would be responsible for travel and hotel accommodations on their own. You must serve on the board for 1 year to be eligible to go, and attendance is done on a rotating basis.

Meeting called to order by President, Gail Hardy at 6:03 PM

Minutes: Secretary, Kimberly Roberts provided minutes of the January 2018 meeting. Angi Griffin made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, Chuck McDanal second, all approved.

Treasure Report: Treasurer, Angi Griffin, presented the income statement through 2/8/18 with an ending balance of \$77,148.20. Lynn King made a motion to accept the financial report as presented, Betsy Slay second, all approved.

Mayfaire race budget approval & shirt design - Gail, presented the proposed budget for the 2018 Mayfaire 5K race. The budget is much the same as last year's budget.

With our High 5 Challenge Award being a medal hangar for all of the races, we are looking at offering a Finisher Medal for this race. The medals would be approximately \$2.30 each, 1100 runners, \$2530 for the finisher medals. Gail will research this further and come back to the board with options.

Chuck McDanal made a motion to accept the 2018 Mayfaire 5K Race budget as presented with the provision to add in \$3000 for the finisher medals. Sarah Kozul second, all approved.

Gail also shared the Polk Museum of Art's art work for the shirt, which will be light blue tanks for both men and women.

SSWS Race budget approval & shirt design - Angi & Lynn, presented the 2018 SSWS budget & logo for the race shirt. There will be finisher medals for all three races, same as last year. A few suggestions for the shirt logo were made. The LRC club name/logo will need to be added to the shirt.

Age Group Awards - looking at tumblers with our logo

Overall Awards - Camp chair with our logo

Chuck McDanal made a motion to accept the 2018 Summer Sunrise Watermelon Series budget as presented, Sarah Kozul second, all approved.

Lisbon Photography - SSWS \$80 per race + \$24 for awards. DD \$55 per race + \$25 for awards
Lake 2 Lake - Sydney has a photographer for this race, Chris Thompson.
Mayfaire & AQ need a photographer - Sydney will get information to Gail for Chris.

Location for Double Down 5K - Gail sent out to all board members the proposed courses to look over. Florida Polytec looks good for the race. Great course and plenty of parking. Not a lot of roads we would need to close or block. We could run around the main building for 2 loops.

TABLED - in order to do more research.

Thanks to James - for reviewing the financial Excel spreadsheet and fixing some of the links. We would still like to move to QuickBooks for better accounting.

Board meeting dates - February and March are good for the Community Room, but the rest of the year we will conflict with the Speech & Hearing Board meetings. Gail suggests that we keep the general meetings the same, on the 3rd Thursday of the month, but maybe change the Board meeting to another date.

Board decided to move the Board meeting to the 1st Monday of every month starting with the April meeting. April 2, 2018.

Income State Review 2017, 2016, 2015 - Gail provided spreadsheet comparing all three years. Some things we need to consider for 2018:

We increased the Scholarship money for 2018.
There is some equipment that needs repairing.
Amanda would like us to start providing a small snack for kids on Tuesdays.

Edgewood Mini Storage - currently renting #832 a 10x20 at \$119.00 per month (list \$145), we get a discount.

5x10 rent \$60.00 per month
10x10 rent \$90.00 per month

We need to schedule a day to meet and totally clean out the shed we have now and see if it is needed to rent another smaller storage unit.

Polk Senior Games 3/10/18 - Louis, Bob & Sherry will work this race. If anyone else is able to come out and help let Louis know and fill out the waiver.

Setting up LRC tent at Promise Run - Saturday, March 3, 2018 - we need volunteers to set up and man the tent before, during and after the race. Lake Mirror is the start and finish for the new course. Amanda may be able to help with this based on schedule. Sydney will help out.

Donation to YMCA - approval needed \$1500.00 - 2017 part of our Lake to Lake 10K race. Sarah Kozul made a motion to send \$1500.00 to the YMCA for the 2017 donation, Lynn King second, all approved.

Florida Poly Pi Run 5K - held at Florida Polytechnic University on 3/17/18, wants to borrow our clock. Louis will go with the clock.

Donation request from Brady Zimmerman - for George Jenkins High School Track. \$35, \$45, \$100, \$250, \$500, \$1000. After a brief discussion, the board decided to decline this request.

Donation request from Lincoln Avenue Academy - Charter School fund raiser Jog-a-thon. Gold \$250, Platinum \$500
Sarah made a motion to donate \$100 anonymously to Lincoln Avenue Academy for their Jog-a-thon, Lynn King second, all approved.

Heartland for Children - closed in Polk County so we will be reviewing the Rudolph Round Up donation. We collected toys at the Christina 5K/Double Down 5K each year to donate to them. We will take a look at Toys for Tots, Florida Baptist Children's Home and Hearth - Polk Co Schools to continue this toy donation.

Schedule the shed clean out day - in March or April, inventory everything and replace broken equipment.

The clean out date will be April 21, 2018 at 9:30 AM. All race directors need to gather all their signed waivers and organize them by year to be stored in the shed.

Posting non LRC races on our FB page - we delete them unless they are one of our sponsors, we do offer to put all races on the calendar on our website.

Christmas Party - Rhonda, party will be December 8, 2018 at the Imperial Swann Hotel. Rhonda has emailed Bert Howard to see if he would consider being the DJ again this year, Kimberly will get Rhonda the information for another DJ.
Sarah made a motion to have Ben McConnell provide his photo booth at the Christmas Party, Gail Hardy second, all approved.

Membership - how is this new system working out? Rebecca reported that she has received positive comments on the new system.

Volunteering tracking & sign up program - Lynn & Sarah - would like to use "Sign Up Genius" to help make this transition more user friendly. \$249/annually and can be customized per each race for volunteers.

Chuck McDanal made a motion to use Sign up Genius for a year@ \$249, Jacob Deese second, all approved.

Hill workouts - they are working on a shirt design and will start tracking attendance on March 1, 2018.

Coolers - Gail, we need to purchase some new coolers.

110 quarts with handle and wheels, Amazon \$118.80

We will wait on the coolers until we clean out the shed and see exactly what we need to purchase.

Meeting called to order by President, Gail Hardy at 6:02 PM

Minutes: Secretary, Kimberly Roberts, provided minutes of the February 2018 meeting. Kurtis Braun made a motion to accept the minutes with corrections, Sarah Kozul second, all approved.

Treasure Report: Treasurer, Angi Griffin, presented the income statement through 2/28/18, with an ending balance of \$72,669.91. Lynn King made a motion to accept the income statement as presented, Kurtis Braun second, all approved.

Mayfaire race update - Gail, shirt will be light blue tanks for both male and female. Finisher medal will be same as age group medal just smaller and with different ribbons.

Packet Stuffing - would like to do away with the packet for this race and give all registered runners a special gift - bib boards.

Bib Boards - these are bib holding devices that snap on to your run shirt. We can have these imprinted with our club logo a set of 4 would be \$3.75, Gail got them to reduce the price to \$2/set if we order 1000 sets, with a \$50 freight fee.

The board decided to order 4,000 bib board sets imprinted with our club logo, Gail will check on the price for this quantity.

Kristi made a motion to purchase 4,000 Bib Board sets at \$2/set, or less. Vicki Powell second, all approved.

We will hand these bib boards out to all registered runners with their bib at packet pick up. We will also feature a table at the race for all Sponsor items for runners to pick up on their own.

Medal design - AG 3.25" - Finisher 2.5" - Ribbons 1.5"

Promoting - 1st time finisher medal, we need to promote this medal for this race, and the start of the High Five Challenge.

SSWS race update - Lynn & Angi, provided the final shirt design.

Sarah Kozul made a motion to accept the shirt design for the SSWS as presented, Chuck McDanal second, all approved.

Lake to Lake budget approval and design - Sydney, provided the proposed budget, this is not final as we are still waiting on shirt and medal pricing. Unique medal design for age group winners of 1,2,3 with swan logo in the middle. Finisher medal will have the swan logo. Looking at a grey shirt for the race. Sydney will get final pricing for shirts and medals to Gail to pass onto the board for approval.

Milton, years ago Lake to Lake 10K was a money race, could we go back to that? Gail, will check on all the paperwork needed to see if this is possible for future years.

Gail, Publix gave a \$250 sponsorship for Lake to Lake 10K.

Sydney, would like to see the after-race food for this done differently this year and feature local food and drink as in a To-Go type box for each runner.

Aching Quad challenge budget approval and design - Kristi, provided the proposed budget and shirt design, shirts will be \$13.90 this year, \$2 more than last year. Kristi does not have final pricing on the medals and would like to upgrade the finisher medal this year for those that complete the entire 4 race challenge. There will not be a kids race this year.

Kristi will be stepping down as race director after the 2018 race, would like someone to come on board with her this year to shadow the races and be ready to take over next year.

After party is all set for Fresco's.

Bib Boards (bib clips) purchase or give out or purchase and sell - See Mayfaire discussion. The board voted to order and give out to all registered runners at Mayfaire and also at our other races.

Spring Ahead Beginning Program - Betsy, 75 people registered. Registration will remain open until 3/24/18. 1st session went very well, with 13 volunteers. Betsy still has some of the yellow shirts left from last year and plans to offer a ladies tank option this year as well.

Club shirts - Gail, inventory low use the "We are LRC Team shirts" unisex to fill in. We need to pick a new shirt color; the grey was not popular.

Chuck, can we look at doing men's and women's shirts this go around. Look at getting some type of storage bins with drawers for ease in locating shirts sizes and keeping inventory.

Shirt colors - blue (2015), grey (2014 not popular), green - white.

Gail will get some samples of shirts and colors for the next meeting.

Polk Senior Games 3/10 - Louis, Bob & Sherry - update. Louis brought the \$300 check for timing this event. One of our timing machines (Chromix Machine) is not working, Louis would like to get pricing on repairing as well as replacing with a new machine.

We will not be timing the Polk Senior Games anymore. Will notify them that they will need to make other arrangements with another timing company for 2019 and beyond.

Add "cold wet towels" at finish line of all our races during hot times - Louis, would like to see us provide these for our runners. Louis will get some pricing and bring back to the board for discussion.

Florida Poly Pi Run 5K - at Florida Polytechnic University on 3/17, wants to borrow our clock - Louis will take care of this, race start is 7:30 am.

Hill workouts - they are working on a shirt design. Kick off at the General Monthly Meeting on 3/15/18. Dave Quarles will be keeping track of the hill workout attendance or participants to receive their shirts.

DD 5K race location - Kurtis, has looked at the Lake Parker Park route, has a lot of turns. Still trying to get ahold of someone at Poly Tech.

Two A-Frame signs for LRC race finish line - vinyl laminate with our logo on both sides. They will add Velcro strips on one side so we can add sponsor logos. \$337.47 for both signs, from Fastsigns in Lakeland. These will be used at the finish line so they are in our finish line photos.

Sarah Kozul made a motion to purchase two A-Frame signs for \$337.47, Lynn King second, all approved.

Milton, we could also use A-Frame mile markers for our races, these are much easier to place along the race routes. Gail will get pricing on for mile markers.

Cross Country - Sarah, would like to go ahead and set a sign-up price for the LRC Lightning Team at \$50/child. This would include their uniform and race entry fees.

Amanda Speakman made a motion to see the sign-up fee for LRC Lightning Cross Country Team at \$50 per child. Chuck McDanal second, all approved.

We will start practice on 4/10/18 and go through the end of October. We had 30 runners last year. We will need another coach for this year.

Kids Running - Amanda, needs a first aid kit to have at kids running program, she will purchase and turn in receipt.
